





**SUBJECT:** Concealed Deadly Weapons

The legislation that would have incorporated the Finance and Administration Cabinet's concealed deadly weapons prohibition in state buildings did not pass the 1998 General Assembly. As a result, the present regulation prohibiting this will sunset on April 15, 1998.

I have directed the Finance and Administration Cabinet's Department for Facilities Management to remove the signs that prohibit the carrying of concealed deadly weapons on state property. However, it has come to my attention that some agencies independently installed these signs. Those signs should also be removed by the agencies that displayed them.
